



Godmanchester Town FC – Membership & Photograph Consent Agreement

Please read the information below carefully. By continuing with registration, you are confirming that you have read and agreed to these terms on behalf of your child.

1. Fines & Data Use

- You accept responsibility for any fines incurred by your child due to misconduct or failure to disclose relevant information while representing Godmanchester Town FC.
- The personal information you provide will be securely held by the Club, shared only with authorised Club personnel, and will not be passed to third parties unless required by law or FA regulation.
- Information is reviewed and collected annually, and previous season data is securely deleted.

2. Health & Conduct Responsibilities

- While Godmanchester Town FC takes all reasonable care, it does not accept responsibility for injury or loss of property during Club activities.
- The Club holds Public Liability Insurance and basic Personal Accident Insurance. Parents are advised to consider taking out personal insurance for their child to cover accidents and injuries.
- Any relevant medical information, allergies or additional needs must be provided as part of your registration to help us support player welfare appropriately.

3. Safety at Bearscroft Lane

- The A1198 is a dangerous road. Parents must deliver and collect their child directly at the Bearscroft Lane ground.
- The Club does not take responsibility for supervising children crossing the A1198 on foot or by bike.

4. Medical Emergencies

If a parent or guardian is not present during a training session or match, the team manager or assistant manager is authorised to seek immediate medical assistance if needed.

5. Club Kit

- Kit provided by the Club remains Club property and must be returned in good condition when a player leaves the Club.

6. FA Respect Code of Conduct

- All players, parents, spectators and coaches must follow The FA Respect Codes of Conduct.
- By agreeing to this form, you confirm you have read and understood the relevant Code(s), available via your team manager or the Club Welfare Officer.

7. Photography & Media Consent

- The Club may use photographs or video recordings of players for promotional, training or celebratory purposes across official channels (e.g., website, newsletters, social media).
- Content will be used in accordance with FA safeguarding guidelines.
- **If you wish to withdraw your consent at any time, please speak to your team manager or contact the Club Welfare Officer.**
